Committee Reports:

Architectural - Nothing to report

Received a couple of proposals regarding front entrance they are reviewing.

There was a request to seed in the Ryan area. Harriet asked if it is in Woodlands contract to seed the new section and what about new pine needles?

Scott reported that they will begin in the cobblestone area on 3/17. They will then go into Laurel Park. They will be seeding, fertilizing. Lime and post emergent. That is safe to do all at once. It is not in the contract to do any more pine needles in the Ryan section where the work was done to put the well & irrigation in. Looking into finding money to do pine needles now so it will look better this summer, instead of waiting until fall.

Jim reported that he met with Tim Simpson (Roadside environment engineer with NC DOT) they discussed the front entrance and what our limitations may be. Also what permits are necessary. He is looking in to why only one side of the current hard scape says Laurel Park. Rhee commented that she does not think the city of concord will approve our plans as is with hard scape.
